

Paper Sculpture

Use plain, coloured, patterned or magazine paper

- Cut into strips and shapes
- Fold, zigzag, curl, roll and twist the pieces
- Try twisting small rectangles into bow shapes
 Join the pieces with glue/tape to create your sculpture

2D to 3D Drawing

Draw a circle by tracing around the bottom of something round like a cup.

Now draw or trace a simple body shape like a circle, triangle or square.
