
Create a game with easily accessed items from home.

MAKER SPACE ACTIVITY

Requirements:

- \cdot Game must be able to be packed up easily and quickly.
- \cdot Must be safe for those playing the game, those watching and for the area that it is conducted in.
- e.g. Nothing flying across the room that will hit beautiful picture frames and smash them!!
- \cdot Game needs set up instructions. This could be a diagram or step by step instructions or both!
- \cdot Game needs rules and a scoring structure. E.g.Each goal from 1 metre away is worth 2 points but
- if you are 1.5 metres away it is worth 3 points. These need to be agreed upon and written down

before the game is played.

- · Once you have drawn up the instructions, rules and scoring structure you can get playing and test out your game. Make sure you fix up your instructions, rules or scoring structure if you make changes after testing out your game.
- If you want to look at the examples from Mrs B, click pause when they are on the screen on the video.
